

Western Pickaway County Driving Tour

From Circleville proceed West on US Route 22. The first road to the left is Mill Road. Take this road to the left. Follow it to the stop sign. Make a left onto Canal Road. Canal Road follows the path of the Ohio & Erie Canal. Your first stop is **Canal Park**. This park has a walking path and shelter house. Following the walking path will bring you to the Towpath Trail along the Canal and was used by the horses and mules towing canal boats back in the 1800's. The Park and Path are owned and maintained by the Pickaway County Park District. Leaving the park turn left to continue to follow along the Ohio & Erie Canal.



Canal Road ends at State Route 104. Cross State Route 104 to Sisk Road. Follow Sisk Road to US Route 22 – cross US Route 22 to Smith Hulse Road. Follow Smith Hulse

Road to Yankeetown Pike. Make a left on Yankeetown Pike, then a quick right onto French Road then make a left turn onto US Route 56 West. Follow US 56 to “Pherson” which is the intersection of Pherson Pike and State Route 56 West. Make a left onto Pherson Pike and pass the Westfall Schools. The first road to the right is Randall Road. Make a right turn onto Randall Road and follow it to “**HoneyRun Farms**”.

HoneyRun Farms is an apiary with over 400 hives. They produce and sell raw honey and many honey related products. In addition, they grow organic vegetables. Stop and visit with the Isaacs at HoneyRun Farm.



When you come out of the farm turn right onto Randall Road. Follow Randall Road to Justus Road. Make a left onto Justus Road. Follow Justus Road to Yankeetown Pike. Make a right onto Yankeetown Pike. Make sure you bear right at the “Y”. continue to follow Yankeetown Pike to the entrance to **Deer Creek State Park and Lodge**. Follow the road to the Lodge where you can enjoy an overnight visit or an incredible meal and relax at “The Rafters”.



After a scrumptious lunch, turn left out of the Park onto Yankeetown Pike. Follow it to State Route 207. Make a left onto State Route 207.

There are many trails, picnic areas, boat ramps and lake access points off of State Route 207 for Deer Creek State Park.



Follow Route 207 to US Route 22. Turn Left onto US Route 22 East bound. Follow it to **A & R Alpaca Farm & Store** at 10981 US Route 22.

Visit with the Ridenours and tour the farm where they raise over 100 alpacas. Visit the store to feel the very soft alpaca fur which is used to make many products to keep you warm.

Leaving the Alpaca Farm turn right onto US Route 22 going east.

Go into Williamsport. In Williamsport at the traffic light make a right onto Water Street which becomes Chillicothe Pike. Follow it South out of Town for several miles. You are going to go through some wonderful farm country along Deer Creek.



Follow Chillicothe Pike to **Blossoms at the Bend** located at 5564 Williamsport-Chillicothe Pike where you can smell, touch, hold and pick Flowers. (Open 7 days a Week Dawn to Dusk).

Leaving Blossoms at the Bend turn left onto Chillicothe Pike. Follow it to State Route 138 turning right. Follow State Route 138 to US Route 22. Make a right onto US Route 22 East bound. Follow it back to Circleville. We hope you enjoyed your day.
