Food Vendor Information

1. Set-Up anytime after 2:00 PM and be ready to serve the public at 5:00 PM sharp. By 4:30 PM all vendor vehicles must be removed from the festival area and parked off site.
2. Vendors will be provided with a 10 by 10 foot tent space, one 6 foot banquet table and a trash receptacle. Signage will be placed at your tent to identify your business.
3. Electricity is 110 volt, 20 amp, for those that require electric.
4. Vendors must bring latex gloves and any other items required by the Pickaway County Health District for handling of food.
5. Vendors agree to provide food items for sale between the hours of 5 PM and 9 PM.
6. Vendors must bring signs identifying items for sale and the cost (number of tickets).
7. Vendors supply their own condiments, napkins, plates and or bowls, and utensils.
8. All beverage sales are the exclusive right of the Summer Event Series. Food vendors are **not permitted** to sell beverages.
9. Food and beverage tickets are available for purchase for \$1.00 per ticket, and will be sold by Summer Event Series volunteers. The vendors will collect the tickets as they sell food items. You will be provided a receptacle to collect the tickets.
10. Vendors must donate 25% of their sales back to the Attract Tourism Foundation, Inc for the Summer Event Series in lieu of an entry fee.
11. Please bring table covers, decorations, and flyers/promotional items for your space.
12. Vendors may bring flyers, menus and any items to promote their business.
13. For the Pizza Challenge, trophies will be presented for various categories, and selected by celebrity judges as well as people's choice voted in by the attending crowd. A voting container will be placed at the information tent for patrons to deposit their voting ticket in. Voting will end at 8:00 PM and the winners of the 2018 Pizza Challenge will be announced by 8:30 PM.
